- To facilitate a multi-stakeholder regional water partnership acting as a platform for interaction
- -To facilitate stakeholder engagement and donors' support for dialogue and action to promote IWRM at national and regional levels
- To make the principles of sustainable water use and IWRM widely recognised and applied, through information & experience sharing

Collaboration between GWP-Med and MENBO



- -- River Basin Organisations represent the key level for water management = the local water management.
- The multi-stakeholder regional water partnership within GWP-Med, has benefited substantially from MENBOs active engagement in its activities, that have brought up local perspectives and challenges.
- MENBO is an active Member of the GWP-Med Partnership Council since 2002.
- MENBO is an Activity Leader in the GWP-Med Work Plans, every year since 2003. Emphasis of activities is on building the capacity of the RBOs network (meetings in Valencia, Marrakech, Athens, Rome etc).
- Further targeted collaborations are under development for activities at the regional (eg. through MED EUWI) and at the local level (eg. for the Balkans)
- GWP-Med looks forward to continue its very close collaboration with MENBO!
