The specificity of the International Network of Basin Organizations is that it organizes cooperation and exchanges between its members on <u>institutional and economic</u> topics.

It is indeed a priority to provide the means for direct exchange of experience and information between the organizations interested or directly involved in water management in the basins of rivers, lakes and aquifers, either national or transboundary, especially on the following topics:

- Laws and regulations for water resource management in your countries,
- Agreements, conventions and international reports on overall water resources management, in transboundary river basins in particular,
- Statutes, assignments and financial resources of basin organizations,
- Norms, standards, frames of reference,
- Integrated information and monitoring systems and databases,
- Water financing and use of the "user-polluter-pays" principle,
- Adaptation to the effects of climate change,
- Involvement of water users and Basin Committees, the river contracts,
- Public consultation,
- Planning and multi-year action plans,
- All the written and video documents published by the basin organizations,
- New interesting websites,
- Events and activities organized on the topic of river basin management, especially the COPs on climate change, the New York High Level Political Forum, the Global Climate Action Summit in San Francisco, the "Europe-INBO 2018" conference in Seville, etc.,
- Training courses, seminars and practical training, etc.,
- Projects initiated within "INBO Action Plan", by our Regional Networks and our Partners,
- Joint projects with large multilateral organizations, etc.

Scientific and technological cooperation is of course mainly covered by <u>other</u> existing organizations or international networks, such as the I.H.P. IWRA, etc.

In addition to our Website: www.inbo-news.org , the "INBO Newsletter" is our privileged liaison tool.

The same newsletter will be published in French, Spanish, English and Russian.

The 27th issue of the newsletter is scheduled for early 2019.

In order to meet this deadline, articles should be sent to INBO Secretariat at IOWater - Paris, before <u>15 OCTOBER 2018</u>, <u>last date</u>:

- * One typed page maximum Arial 11 and 9 **2,500 characters (spaces included)** for each brief information,
- * With contrasted photographs or colored diagrams/maps (jpg format high resolution size bigger than 700 K),
- * With a translation into the three official languages of the Network: French, English, Spanish,
- * According to the appended (characters) model (WORD for PC or MAC) ONLY by e-mail.

No text on paper will be taken into consideration whether sent by fax or surface mail (only by e-mail) to riob@riob.org.

The Newsletter will also inform the members about the proceedings of the Liaison Bureau meetings and events organized or projects implemented by INBO, its Regional Networks and the Global Alliances for Water and Climate (GAfWaC), or to which it is associated.
