# Priority for Action 1.5.9. "Keeping capacity building on water management smart and simple: the twinning approach"



Thursday March 15<sup>th</sup>, 2012: 17h - 19h

#### 1. Additional ideas & solutions

- Twinning between transboundary river basin organisations and their sub-basins organisations at national level (upstream, downstream or on tributaries and lakes) offer great synergies, especially when tackling with monitoring, capacity building and planning issues.
- Twinning help avoiding reproducing mistakes made by sister-institutions and allow to better understand the long term perspective, even if the sustainable way is a bit more costly on the short term (immediate necessary costs for ownership, participative planning, capacity building); the exchange of experiences represents the background of this improvement
- Twinning can be developed at national level (legal and institutional frameworks; financial mechanisms ...), river basin level (governance for river basin institutions) or local level (water, sanitation, pollution control adaptated solutions).

#### 2. Final list of commitments

- At international level, responding to the request by the UN General Assembly in its resolution of 26 July 2010, French water agencies are committed to provide 1% of their financial resources for sustainable international cooperation actions, by 2015 (or 20M € / year), in the field of water and sanitation.
- French water agencies will keep on providing support to institutional twinning river basins for foreign countries seeking to promote the establishment of river basin organizations or strengthening existing structures.
