DESCRIPTION:

Climate change is no longer a challenge for generations to come: it's a present day problem. The negative impacts of climate change are already affecting areas all around the world. First and foremost, these impacts manifest themselves through changes in the water cycle, such as unpredictable changes in rainfall patterns, reduction of snow cover and melting of glaciers that alter river flows, salinization of coastal groundwater as a result of sea level rise, more frequent and intense floods and droughts. Water-related disasters represent 90% of all natural disasters. It is therefore of the utmost importance to develop projects of adaptation to climate change in the water sector, and

in particular in the basins of rivers, lakes and aquifers where lie our freshwater resources. This is the objective of the Paris Pact on water and adaptation to climate change in basins, launched at COP21, which now gathers a community of more than 350 signatories.
