

- Managing conflict and Maximising Linkages












## **Progressing Adaptation (managing the environment)**

"As climate change reveals itself it is probable that we will no longer be able to sustain, unaltered, the environments which we have worked so hard to protect and conserve over preceding decades. For environmentalists, we have to ask ourselves when preserving the status quo becomes simply unsustainable, under likely future climates, and therefore a poor adaptation response."
